This kitten/cat is being sold as a pet and companion animal.

The Buyer is granted all rights with respect to showing the kitten/cat; however, the kitten/cat is not being sold as a show kitten/cat. The granting of showing rights does not imply potential show-related guarantees of any kind. The Buyer acknowledges that the Breeder makes no guarantees about achieving any results in shows or the acquisition of any titles.

Pedigree Guarantee: The Breeder guarantees that the kitten/cat is a purebred Bengal, with an accurate pedigree, and has been registered with The International Cat Association, Inc. (TICA) as part of a litter. The Buyer can request to have the kitten/cat registered with the Canadian Cat Association (CCA) for an additional fee of \$25.00.

Genetic Guarantee: The kitten/cat is guaranteed against the following genetic defects (PK Def and PRA) up to the age of two (2) years.

If the kitten/cat is found to have any of these conditions within the guarantee period, the Buyer will be entitled to a replacement kitten/cat, at the Breeder's cost. In order to receive a replacement kitten/cat:

- a) The Buyer must notify the Breeder of the condition prior to the end of the guarantee period.
- b) The Buyer must permit the veterinarian to disclose any and all veterinary information pertaining to the kitten/cat.
- c) The veterinarian must provide proof that confirms the genetic disorder (please note that this may require a pathological autopsy).
- d) The kitten/cat must be returned to the Breeder.

Health Guarantee: The Breeder warrants that the kitten/cat has been examined at least twice by a veterinarian. The Breeder will provide the Buyer with an up-to-date health and immunization record for the kitten/cat at the time of delivery.

The Buyer agrees to have the kitten/cat examined by a licensed veterinarian within 5 days after receiving the kitten/cat. The Buyer agrees to keep the kitten/cat quarantined from all other animals prior to this examination.

If the kitten/cat is found to have any life-threatening illness or untreatable disease during this examination, the Buyer can choose to have the kitten/cat replaced at the Breeder's cost. In order to receive a replacement kitten/cat:

- a) The Buyer must notify the Breeder of the illness or disease within 24 hours of discovery.
- b) The Buyer must permit the veterinarian to disclose any and all veterinary information pertaining to the kitten/cat.
- c) If it is safe to do so, the Buyer will return the kitten/cat to the Breeder's facility, if not, the Buyer explicitly permits the Breeder to direct the veterinarian's treatment of the kitten/cat (at the Breeder's expense).
- d) The kitten/cat may not be euthanized without prior permission from the Breeder.
- e) The Breeder is no longer responsible for any condition found after the examination including any instance of FeLV, FIV, FIP or any other bacterial or viral infectious diseases, parasites or fungus (due to the fact that these can be contracted anywhere in the environment after leaving the Breeder). The Buyer accepts all responsibility for the protection of the kitten/cat from said diseases, illnesses, parasites and fungi.

If the examination does not occur within 5 business days or the Buyer does not keep the Cat quarantined prior to the examination, the Buyer cannot choose to have the kitten/cat replaced at the Breeder's cost based on this guarantee.

Replacement Cat: If a replacement kitten/cat is requested through this contract, the replacement kitten/cat will be of equal value, and the replacement will be made as soon as a kitten/cat of equivalent quality, color, pattern, and gender becomes available. The original kitten/cat must be returned to the Breeder. The Breeder is not liable for any veterinarian fees, tests, treatment, carrier, or shipping pertaining to the replacement kitten/cat (including but not limited to standard veterinarian examinations and neutering / spaying). The replacement kitten/cat is subject to all of the same conditions and clauses in this Agreement.

If this contract has been breached or if the kitten/cat has been allowed outdoors (without adequate human supervision and protection), declawed, or if the Buyer has failed to provide adequate nourishment, housing, veterinary care or social attention then the Breeder will not be required to provide a replacement cat and the guarantee of a replacement cat is void.

Responsibility of Buyer: The Buyer assumes responsibility for the welfare of the kitten/cat. The Buyer will at all times provide the with appropriate care, including but not limited to nourishment, housing, veterinary care, and social attention.

Transfer of Ownership: If the Buyer transfers ownership or possession of the kitten/cat to another party, the Buyer must notify the Breeder prior to the transfer and provide the Breeder with the name, address, and phone number of the new owner or caregiver.

Marketing Rights: The Breeder reserves the right to use photos of the kitten/cat (while still in the Breeder's care) in any or all advertising, including website advertising in the promotion of the Breeder. The Buyer agrees to allow the Breeder the right to use the kitten/cat's photographs or name in future or existing advertising.
